### NARRATIVE

On 03/10/04 while investigating leads pertaining to the murder of Kent EITHOLT, an individual by the name of Nichols GILPIN was interviewed. ILPIN advised me that a friend of his by the name of Charles ERICKSON, better nown as Chuck, had told GILPIN directly that ERICKSON and another individual y the name of Ryan FERGUSON were responsible for the murder of Kent HEITHOLT n the morning after Halloween 2001.

With the information we had obtained from GILPIN and other witnesses, e then decided to locate ERICKSON and bring him to the Columbia Police Dept. fficer Ted Anderson arrived with ERICKSON at approximately 09:10 hours and RICKSON was escorted into a private interview room of the investigative unit.

I entered into the room shortly before 09:22 hours and introduced yself. I asked ERICKSON if he needed anything to drink, or needed to use the estroom, and he stated he did not. At 09:22 hours I removed a Miranda rights ard from my pocket, read ERICKSON his Miranda rights directly off of this card nd asked him if he understood his rights. ERICKSON stated he did. I asked f he would answer questions, and ERICKSON stated, "Yes." I then obtained ersonal information, i.e., residence, employment, etc.

After a short conversation about his personal life, I told ERICKSON hat GILPIN had told me that ERICKSON and FERGUSON had committed the murder at he Tribune on the morning after Halloween 2001. ERICKSON'S immediate response as "I don't even remember it." ERICKSON stated he had talked to FERGUSON ears later about the night they were at By George night club. RICKSON stated they had run out of cash, and had been continually borrowing oney from FERGUSON'S sister. He stated he could not remember FERGUSON'S ister's name. ERICKSON stated at one time during the night, FERGUSON'S sister tated she was no longer going to provide them with money, and ERICKSON stated e left to "rouse someone up for some money." ERICKSON stated he had seen the ews release about the murder in the paper the next day. ERICKSON told me he id not know if he was drunk, or if he just refused to remember it, but he tated on Halloween night earlier in the evening before the incident occurred, ERGUSON had told him he wanted to kill someone before he had turned 60. RICKSON then stated, "I got sick after I hit him. I think Ryan strangled him fter that, I think I saw it."

I then asked ERICKSON if he had seen it or not, and I asked him if he ad seen FERGUSON strangle the victim. ERICKSON then stated he had seen ERGUSON strangle him out of the corner of his eye. ERICKSON stated he thought

It that point that he was saying something to a cleaning lady who was at the back door of the business (the Tribune). ERICKSON stated after he saw the cleaning lady, he sat down beside a vehicle, and said he became physically sicle stated he saw FERGUSON standing over the guy and "strangling him."

IRICKSON stated the victim was laying on his back when FERGUSON was strangling him. FERGUSON was strandling the victim as he strangled him according to IRICKSON.

ERICKSON continued by saying as they were walking up to the parking lot of the Tribune, FERGUSON had asked him to hit the guy with something. ERICKSON laims he does not remember how many times he hit the victim because he had otten sick. I then told ERICKSON that he was being vague with his answers, and that GILPIN had told us the truth because he had a conscience. I felt that RICKSON was not being totally forthcoming, but I did feel like he wanted to ell us more. I then asked him to just tell us the truth.

ERICKSON told me they left the club because they had ran out of money o buy drinks. He stated they went to the Tribune and "we attacked a guy, I on't know if Ryan held him or hit him." I then asked ERICKSON if he had hit he victim, and what he hit him with. ERICKSON stated he hit him with a wrench r something from FERGUSON'S car. ERICKSON stated they obtained the wrench hich he described as a tire tool from the trunk of the car, and stated he does ot remember if FERGUSON retrieved the wrench or if he had gotten it out of the ehicle himself. I asked ERICKSON if he had seen this wrench, and ERICKSON tated he did not remember whether or not he or FERGUSON hit the victim, but he tated he did get sick, and he did see the victim fall to the ground. I then sked directly if he was the individual who hit the victim, or was t FERGUSON. ERICKSON stated that he hit HEITHOLT in the head with the tire ool.

I then asked how the victim died, and ERICKSON stated, "Don't know if a was dead then, but Ryan made sure of it." I asked how FERGUSON made sure hat HEITHOLT was dead, and ERICKSON stated, "Strangled him."

I then asked ERICKSON if he had said something to the cleaning lady sfore or after FERGUSON had strangled the victim. ERICKSON stated he did not now, he thought he said something to the lady at that time, but was not sure. told ERICKSON that the cleaning lady told the police that someone asked for slp. ERICKSON stated that was him. I then asked ERICKSON how they had left ne area, and he said they returned to the By George night club, because that's nere they had gone earlier that night. ERICKSON stated they had parked on ne restaurant parking lot next to By George. He stated as they were leaving ne Tribune, ERICKSON stated he ran into a friend of his by the name of Dallas LLORY. ERICKSON states that MALLORY saw "us leaving the Tribune." ERICKSON old MALLORY what occurred, and told him what FERGUSON had done. He also

tated he told MALLORY that they had just left the parking lot and they had eat down a guy back there. MALLORY was also in the company of two females at hat time according to ERICKSON.

ERICKSON then asked me if there was vomit at the scene, and I told him was not going to discuss the evidence of the case with him. I told RICKSON we would be talking to FERGUSON also, and I felt like it was possible e would tell the truth, and I wanted to know who caused the death of HEITHOLT t that point ERICKSON stated, "I may have hit him." I asked if he hit him ith a wrench, and ERICKSON stated, "Yeah, I think I may have hit him." He aused and continued saying, "Yes, I did." ERICKSON then stated, "I'm sure I it him, because that's what made me sick." I then asked ERICKSON if he ctually vomited, and he stated he did not remember.

I asked ERICKSON where the wrench was that he had used to assault the ictim, and he stated he did not know. ERICKSON did not know if ERGUSON removed it from the scene. I asked ERICKSON whose idea it was to ommit this robbery, and ERICKSON stated it was FERGUSON'S idea, that he anted to rob somebody. ERICKSON stated FERGUSON was the one who retrieved the rench out of the car and started walking toward the Tribune. ERICKSON stated, We then saw a big bald guy on the lot." I asked ERICKSON who made the first ontact with the victim, and he stated he did not who said or did what first, at he remembers saying something to the victim. ERICKSON stated he did not ecall what it was. ERICKSON stated the only thing he could remember was that fter he himself struck HEITHOLT, HEITHOLT screamed. ERICKSON stated it ounded horrible. ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT then went down. ERICKSON tated at that time is when he believes he got sick. He stated he saw a female tanding between the two doors near the loading dock or on the loading dock of ne back of the business. He stated he yelled at her, and he got mad at er because she just stood there. He stated it was at that time FERGUSON was ver the victim. I asked why he was mad at the female, and ERICKSON stated she ist wasn't moving, and she was standing there just looking at them. I then ked if HEITHOLT had hit either he or FERGUSON, and ERICKSON stated HEITHOLT ed kicked him in his testicles. I asked if that is when he hit HEITHOLT, Iter he had been struck in his testicles, and ERICKSON stated that is when he .rst struck HEITHOLT. I asked how many times he hit HEITHOLT and ERICKSON ated just once.

I then explained to ERICKSON that I knew HEITHOLT had been struck more can once due to the massive amount of injuries around his head. I told him ce autopsy revealed there had been more than one strike, and more than one hit Mr. HEITHOLT'S head, and ERICKSON stated, "Yeah, probably." I asked ICKSON if he had hit the victim more than once, and he stated yes. I then ked ERICKSON if the victim HEITHOLT was fighting ERICKSON and FERGUSON. I ked him it was possible HEITHOLT had got one or both of them down, and that

hey were trying to get away from him due to the fact he was such a large an. ERICKSON stated to me, "This was an innocent guy who didn't deserve to ie."

I asked ERICKSON what they had obtained from HEITHOLT after beating him nd strangling him. He stated they may have taken a wallet but he was unsure, e stated he thought that FERGUSON had taken something from the victim's ar. I asked if he knew what it was, and he stated it might have been a shirt. e said he wasn't sure, but he thought he used the shirt to strangle HEITHOLT peaking of FERGUSON doing this. ERICKSON told me FERGUSON contacted him a suple of days, later after this incident, and stated FERGUSON'S father had bund a wallet in his residence, and FERGUSON stated he had gotten in trouble or this. ERICKSON could not say the wallet was HEITHOLTS.

I then asked ERICKSON again who had hit HEITHOLT, and he stated again nat he had. I then asked ERICKSON again how many times he had hit HEITHOLT, and he stated he did not know. I asked ERICKSON if it was multiple times nat he struck HEITHOLT, and he stated, "Yes."

I then asked ERICKSON if Dallas MALLORY had seen the assault and CICKSON replied no. ERICKSON did state someone had chased him, but he did not now who that was. ERICKSON stated he had ran into MALLORY somewhere near the rea of the Break Time on Providence Road. I asked ERICKSON what he and ERGUSON were wearing that night, and he stated they were wearing big, puffy nats. I asked if he still had them, and he stated he did not have his coat, cause after they killed HEITHOLT, they went back to By George's and someone d stolen his coat.

I then directed his attention to the lady who had been standing on the ck dock. I asked ERICKSON if she had gotten scared and ran off, and he said e had ran back into the building. I then asked ERICKSON if he had ever lked to FERGUSON about this, and he stated the first time he had ever talked FERGUSON about this after it happened was on New Years Eve at a party at hn WHITWORTH'S house. He stated this was the New Years Eve party that John ITWORTH had this past New Years Eve (2003/2004). ERICKSON stated they were tside and he said something to FERGUSON about killing the victim on the rking lot and FERGUSON told ERICKSON if he told anybody, he would kill him. ICKSON stated they went outside because they were talking about it inside, to FERGUSON told him he did not want to talk about it.

I asked ERICKSON what exactly was discussed outside the party, and he ated he and FERGUSON had talked about being inside By George. ERICKSON ated when they left By George the night of the murder, they were waiting for erybody to leave the parking lot. ERICKSON stated they waited to ave By George because there was a police officer outside the bar, and they

vere only 17 at the time.

I asked what ERICKSON'S path of travel was after they had murdered EITHOLT, and he could not provide me with a good answer. He stated he almost ould not remember. ERICKSON did state that he remembered climbing up a wooded area". ERICKSON said that he and FERGUSON then returned to ERGUSON'S car. FERGUSON took ERICKSON home and ERICKSON believes FERGUSON hen went home.

At that time I decided to leave the interview room to obtain a video tatement from, ERICKSON. For information pertaining to the video statement, lease see another supplement under this case number.
